ORDINANCE No. 10
P.G. Diploma in Journalism (PGDJ)
Refer Section [35]

- 1 PGDJ is a ONE YEAR (Two Semester) POST–GRADUATE DIPLOMA PROGRAMME, under the Semester Examination Scheme.
- 2 A person who has obtained Bachelor's degree of the University or a degree recognized equivalent thereto shall be eligible for admission to PGDJ Programme. The admission procedure shall be as decided by the University from time to time.
- 3 Admission shall be open to a person residing in India and abroad.
- 4 Reservation shall be followed as per Govt. of India/Govt. of Chhattisgarh rules.
- 5 The medium of Instructions shall be Hindi/English.
- 6 The total intake capacity of the PGDJ course shall be as per UGC norms and as decided by the University from time to time.
- 7 The fees for admission, tuition, examination and other fees shall be prescribed by the University from time to time.
- 8 The scheme of examination and the course curriculum will be prescribed by the University from time to time.
- 9 The examination in written papers shall be held at the end of each semester according to the Syllabus and scheme of examination. The details Scheme of examination and syllabus (as per course as may be in force time to time) shall be published by the University.
- 10 Students who have attended the prescribed number of lectures and obtained minimum prescribed marks in the internal assessment shall be permitted to appear at the written examination.
- 11 A candidate shall be declared passed in semester examination if he/she obtains at least 40% marks each of the theory papers, internal assessments, practical, viva-voce and 45% marks in the aggregate.
12. A candidate, declared pass at the first semester examination shall be eligible to be promoted to the second semester and shall be eligible to take up the second semester examination if he/she fulfills all other conditions to be eligible to appear at the examination.

- 1) If a candidate who fails in maximum two courses shall be allowed to keep the term and shall be eligible for promotion to the second semester, if he has cleared/passed all internal assessment exams.
 - 2) Such candidate as mentioned in subsection (1) under proviso shall be eligible to take examination in such courses of the first semester, in which he has failed, simultaneously with the examination of second semester, subject to the other conditions for eligibility of examination being fulfilled.
 - 3) If the student aforesaid under subsection (2) fails to clear his theory papers of first semester along with the second semester exam then in such case he shall appear as an ex-student in the immediately following first semester examination again.
 - 4) If such a student as described under this proviso fails to clear his theory papers of first semester even in the second attempt as described under proviso (3) he shall cease to be a student of the programme.
13. Such candidates who fail in not more than two theory papers or in aggregate shall be permitted to appear at the next subsequent semester examination. If a candidate fails in more than two theory papers, he will be declared fail and will be permitted to appear as an ex-student at the existing Syllabus.

Provided further that the matters not-provided under this ordinance shall be governed by the general provisions of the ordinance relating to examinations of the University.
